# Minutes Juggers Meeting of 03 25 2021

The monthly ZOOM MEETING of the Juggers was called to order by President Gary Ryan at 7:03 PM. A moment of silence was held to remember Juggers who have passed and those unable to attend.

**Attendance:** There were 19 members in attendance via computer or phone.

**Treasurer's Report:** Sandy reported a treasury balance of \$5,693.73. Lots of dues money is coming in thanks to Raina Michel's suggestion to award a \$100 prize for dues payments made before this, the March Juggers meeting.

**Safety Committee:** No amendments to the rules that affect the classes we run.

**Web Site Report:** JohnL discussed the re-design and building of the Juggers web site and contracting with Nancy Clothier to execute the program. The site is being moved to a new hosting company, new software has been installed to make it easier to update the site and a password protected section will host a swap meet site, a location to pay dues online, and a voluntary member directory will be available only to members with the password. Files from the old site are being copied downloaded to be included in the new site.

The section for Jugger of the Year will be expanded to feature a picture of the permanent plaque with the names of past winners on it. When clicking on any name, a window opens which contains a short article on that winner.

The history section will be a significant part of the new site. Sandy Mendia, club history committee chairperson, will head up the special section to work with Nancy to build this site. She is recruiting other members to help in this monumental task, since she has so much material that she has scanned and available electronically.

**High School Committee:** The High School program re-started March 17, with 25 races currently scheduled. A check for \$375.00 to cover the 2021 High School Free Tech Card program has been issued and sent to Nick Bublitz, Drag Race Manager at Sonoma Raceway.

Until spectators are allowed, we will not have Juggers members volunteering to help at the track on race nights.

The Top the Cops program will be started in April and we are in discussions with Nick regarding our volunteer program and theirs. John will hear from them before the April meeting regarding any special allowance for our volunteers.

We will be reinstituting the full program with awards for series winners and scholarships for the 2021 racing season.

We will also be sending trophies and prizes to past winners when all the information is given to us.

**Picnic Committee** - We had a discussion of the 2021 Picnic and Steve is looking into it further. Currently, the park is taking reservations for small groups, but the reservations do not go out to October, our preferred date. Update – The County is not currently taking reservations even though it's showing on their website. Advised to check back in May. Steve is suggesting Oct.9th if we go forward with the picnic.

**Clubwear** – Eddie now has a considerable inventory of all the great Juggers wearables.

**Old Business –** We continued discussions regarding the prize structure for the "Jar People" who receive the Participation awards for Driver, Crew Member, Car Show and High School Volunteers - and the Bruce Erickson Outstanding Jugger of the Year. The general discussion settled on approximately a \$100 value for the Participant Awards and a \$400 value for the Jugger of the Year Award. The Jugger of the Year Award would also have the winner's name on the perpetual plaque and an individual plaque for the winner to keep. We also decided to prepare a patch for the winner to affix to a jacket or fire suit.

For those members participating in a car show, as driver or crew member at a race, or volunteering at the track for the High School Program on Wednesday nights, you need to submit that information to Raina at <a href="mailto:rainamichel77@gmail.com">rainamichel77@gmail.com</a>. Until we have in person meetings, this is the only way your name will get in the jar for the drawing.

There was some discussion regarding the Little Old Lady as a potential project. Boyd mentioned the place where he keeps his trailer has space available for \$150.00/month. There are several members who want to participate. Paul Risso suggested car to be used for exhibition. No resolution.

# **New Business** – No new business.

There was general discussion after these business items. Boyd Schauer reported that Kingdon Dragstrip wants to repave. They need to raise \$50,000 to do the job.

An electronic wheel was spun to determine the winner of the \$25 prize for one of those attending the Zoom meeting.

Due to the length of the meeting, the monthly trivia contest was not held.

Meeting was adjourned at 9:00 PM.


